Helping Local Children

For over 20 years, “**Berkshire Give A Child A Chance**” has helped countless children benefit from a range of educational and recreational activities in your area.

We need your help.

They may struggle with homework in a new language or need help when peer pressure gets them into trouble.

Do You Know?

- Last year we gave 53 grants of between £300 and £2,000 to voluntary groups working with young people up to age 18. We also directly helped with 30 grants to buy special equipment for disabled or sick children, in addition to essential items out of reach for poorer families.
But we never have enough money to go round for all who apply.
- If everyone in the Slough, Windsor and Maidenhead areas gave just £1 together we could help many more children in need! And please consider using Gift Aid so every £1 is worth £1.28 to us!
- This area has one of the worst records for substance abuse in the UK. Problems of deprivation, poor housing and rising levels of debt affect children's lives.
- We still have pockets of deprivation that continue to affect the development of a large number of young people.
