

Web firm 'takes on property in Slough'

The second floor of Aquasulis in Slough has been let out to 1&1 Limited from Morley, it has been reported.

It is believed that the deal will see the internet company take 5,823 sq ft of office space in a five-year lease, reports Property Mall.

Morley was advised by Strutt & Parker during the deal and a portion of its Thames Valley Direct office portfolio is formed by Aquasulis, the publication stated.

Partner at Strutt & Parker National Markets Jeremy Rodale said that the market in Slough is a strong one and this is a good deal for Morley.

“The office building, which totals 25,000 sq ft, has been a great success for Morley as the take up of office space at Aquasulis has been extremely rapid in comparison with the challenging Slough office market,” he commented.
