

Queen visits Pinewood studios

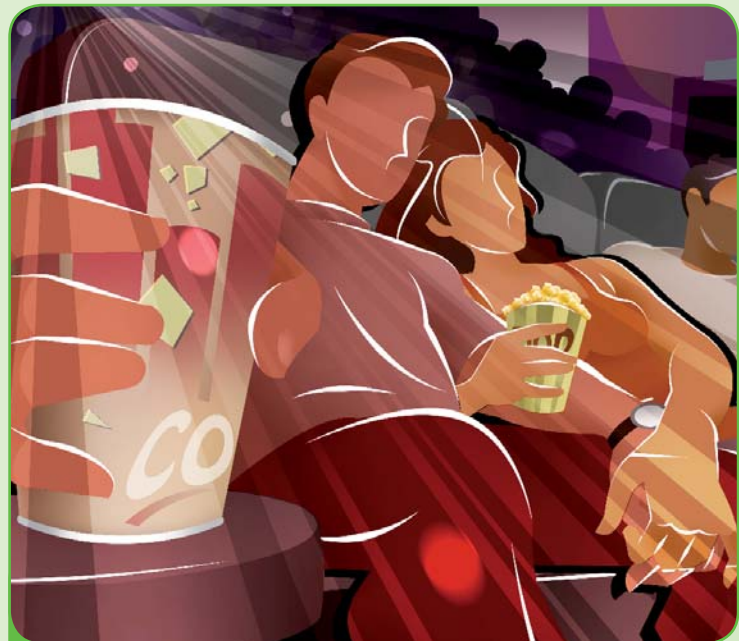
Pinewood Studios got a taste of royalty on Friday and not because one of its current themes had a regal theme, the venue was in fact subject to a visit from the head monarch herself.
