



# Pele comes to Windsor Castle

An exhibition of one of the world's most recognised footballers is set to take place at Windsor Castle Galleries later this month.

**T**he exhibition named *The Beautiful Game* kicks off on the 14th of February 2008, and will be held at the Castle Galleries daily from 9.30am to 6pm weekdays, 9am to 6pm Saturdays and 11am to 5pm Sundays.

The collection includes photographs of the football legend at the peak of his game and some of the most iconic moments of his life. The 8 limited pieces have been signed by the man himself.

The 29 year old Pele led Brazil to victory in the 1970 World Cup final in Mexico. Some of his other achievements include the world record for greatest number of hat tricks (92) and the number of goals scored on an international level (97).

Pele was also made Minister for sport in 1995 after he retired from the game and recently was awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award at the BBC Sports Personality of the Year.

If you fancy picking up a piece of football history then you're in for a treat with the six smaller framed prints retailing for £350 and the two larger framed prints retailing for £699.
