Announcing the release of the Veritas CommandCentral 5.0 range, the company said that the new data storage facilities offer firms a unified approach, news that may be of interest to company directors.

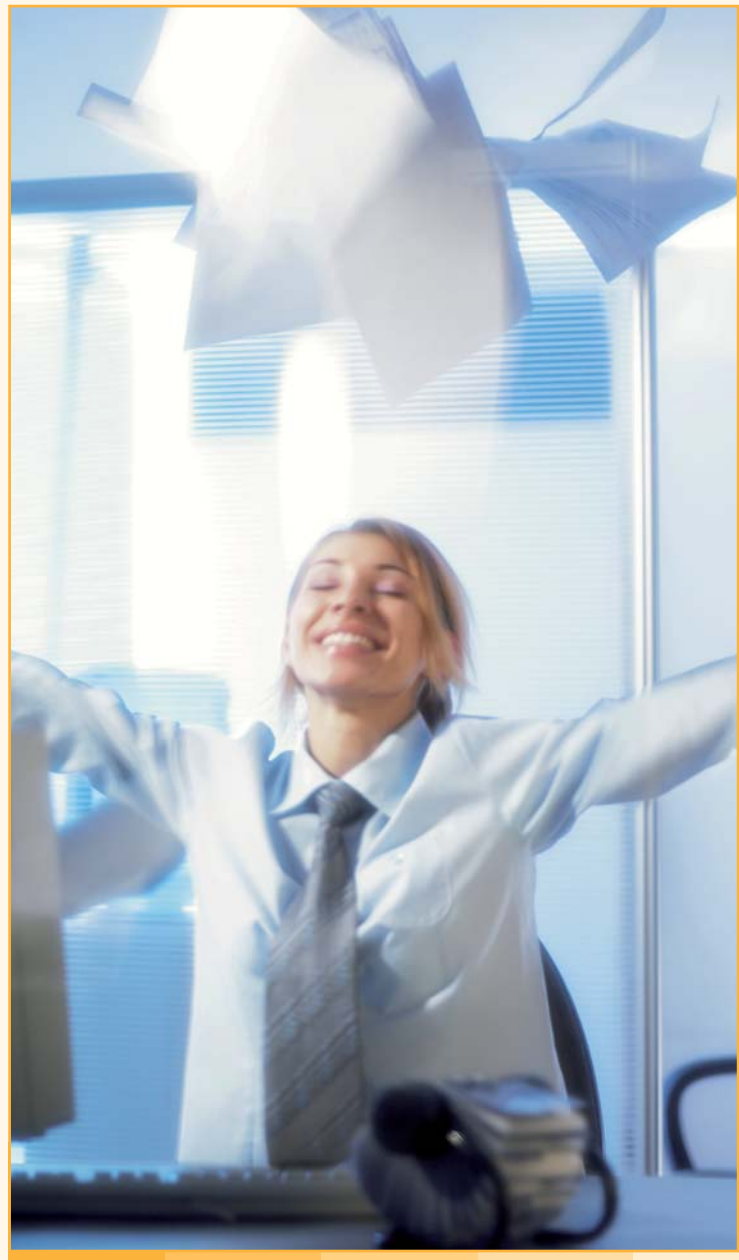
Furthermore, this is the only storage resource management (SRM) equipment to utilise a number of channels such as automated storage processes and to align capabilities with refined business needs, it said.
