Although the repertoire is more contemporary Christian is looking forward to singing Carl Davis' arrangement of "Blow Gabriel Blow" which he recorded with world renowned bass, Willard White as well as Bernstein's "Maria" from West Side Story and Music of the Night from The Phantom of the Opera.
