

Dive In is a class and event-based programme aimed primarily at Level 1 students which can be funded through Wider Key Skills. All hours quoted for each section are the minimum required to achieve the identified funding.

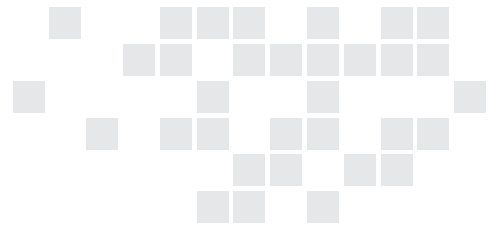

programme contents

Preparation	2 hours
This structured work package allows tutors to prepare students in advance of taking Dive In. Preparation includes understanding the basics of developing an idea and what it feels like to work as a team towards achieving a common goal.	
Dive in: a half-day event including:	4 hours
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Idea creation – working through a range of potential ideas for an event and deciding on which one will be developed into the real thing. ■ Planning – deciding what timescales there are for the event and setting an event date. ■ Money – agreeing what costs will be incurred by the event, including everything from advertising to the event venue and food and drink. ■ Communications – developing a communications approach for the event including an identity, tickets, a slogan and some initial advertising designs. 	
Follow up	3 hours
This structured work package provides tutors with a wide range of activities which build on the learning from the event and enable students to use the skills they gained within appropriate contexts.	
Further work	5 – 11 hours
This structured work package provides tutors with more activities to extend and embed the knowledge acquired over the previous modules.
