<b>Medium risk e.g. light engineering and assembly work, food processing</b>	<b>Fewer than 20</b>	<b>At least one appointed person</b>
	<b>20-100</b>	<b>At least one first aider for every 50 employed (or part thereof)</b>
	<b>More than 100</b>	<b>One additional first aider for every 100 employed</b>
<b>Higher risk e.g. most construction, slaughterhouse, chemical manufacture, extensive work with dangerous machinery or sharp instruments</b>	<b>Fewer than 5</b>	<b>At least one appointed person</b>
	<b>5-50</b>	<b>At least one first aider</b>
	<b>More than 50</b>	<b>One additional first aider for every 50 employed</b>
	<b>Where there are hazards for which additional first aid skills are necessary</b>	<b>In addition, at least one first aider trained in the specific additional first aid skills.</b>
